This beautifully written story is about the character of Sarah Schorr and an old Philadelphia aristocrat “trying” to understand one another, as Biddle is cognizant of this being the final year of his life. Judge Biddle had been Attorney General of the United States. After World War II, he was appointed Chief American Judge of the International Military Tribunal at Nuremberg.
